- Name, email address, phone number, postal address, job role.
- Banking and financial information (for payment and receipt of invoices)
- IP addresses, browser type, device information, access logs
- Marketing & communication data
- Marketing preferences, subscription status, email engagement (opens, clicks).

Information Collected Automatically

We use Google Analytics to understand how visitors interact with our website. This helps us improve our services and user experience. This data is "pseudonymous." It tells us what a browser is doing, but it does not tell us who you are. We do not see your name, home address, or private contact details through Google Analytics.

The following data is collected automatically:

- Technical Device Information
 - Device Type: (e.g., Mobile, Tablet, Desktop)
 - Operating System: (e.g., Windows, iOS, Android)
 - Browser Type: (e.g., Chrome, Safari, Firefox)
 - Screen Resolution: To ensure our site displays correctly on your device.
- Approximate Location Data
 - Geographic Origin: We collect data on your City, Region, and Country.

Note on IP Addresses: While Google Analytics uses your IP address to determine your general location, it is anonymised immediately. We do not have access to, nor do we store, your full IP address.

Referral Source: How you found our website (e.g., via a Google search, a link from another site, or a social media post).

Pages Visited: Which specific pages you viewed and how long you spent on them.

Interaction Data: Links you clicked, documents downloaded (such as validation whitepapers), and videos watched.

Site Path: The sequence of pages you visited during your session.

- **Unique Identifiers (Cookies)**

Client ID: Google Analytics assigns a random, unique string of numbers to your browser. This allows the system to recognize you as a "returning visitor" rather than a brand-new user if you visit us again later.

Information You Provide to Us

If you interact with the site's "Contact Us" forms or inquiry features, the company typically collects:

- **Identity Data:** Full name, Company Name.

- **Inquiry Details:** Any specific information you provide regarding your validation needs, project requirements, or equipment hire requests. We'll use your information to process your request for information.
- **Marketing Choices:** Any specific information you provide regarding your marketing preferences. We'll use your information to contact you about our services and products.
- **Newsletter and Event Interest:** If you register your interest in an event or newsletter this data will be collected. If interested, we'll use your information to register you to receive our newsletters or contact you about our events.

How we use Personal Data

- Legitimate interests – to operate, improve, and secure our services, provided these interests do not override individual rights.
- Consent – for marketing emails where required.
- Legal obligation – to comply with applicable laws and regulations.

Marketing Emails

BPV Ltd sends marketing emails in compliance with UK GDPR and PECR

We send marketing emails only where:

- You have explicitly opted in, or
- A soft opt in applies (existing business relationship).

We do not sell or rent email address to third parties.

Data Sharing

We may share personal data with:

- Trusted service providers (hosting, security, analytics).

- Trusted email service providers for marketing purposes.
